RESOLUTION No. 020625

Adopting the Camden County Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan on this 6th day of February 2025.

Whereas, Camden County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 ("Disaster Mitigation Act") emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards;

Whereas, the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local governments; and

Whereas, an adopted Local Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, Camden County fully participated in the hazard mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, Camden County desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the Camden County Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, adoption by the governing body for Camden County demonstrates the jurisdiction's commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals outlined in this Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, adoption of this legitimizes the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan;

Now, **therefore**, **be it resolved**, that Camden County adopts the "Camden County Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan" as an official plan; and

Be it further resolved, Camden County will submit the updated plan along with this Adoption Resolution to the Missouri State Emergency Management Agency and Federal Emergency Management Agency Region VII officials to enable the plan's final approval.
