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## **Other Business**

**Materials used for county road repairs-** Road and Bridge Administrator Pat Wolf and Shawn from Vance Brothers were present to discuss an option for using a chip seal method over microchipping. Shawn supplied a small bucket of dry material for the commission (and whomever else) to see and feel. Pat Wolf stated that if his department utilized this method, it could save the county an estimated \$178,000.00 on the mileage of roads they have planned for completion in 2025. The estimated life expectancy is between 7-8 years, and one major difference is that roads can be driven on almost immediately once a job is completed versus having to keep the road closed for 2+ hours. Pat Wolf confirmed that this material would not generate white dust like a previous material that was used. There were no motions made.

**Camden County Campus Map- discussion/input-** Administrative Assistant Jordan Stanton, GIS Specialist Sandy Stock, and E-911 Mapping and Addressing Director Mike Lloyd have been working on a plan to create some maps and signs to use around the Camden County campus to assist with getting citizens where they need to be when they're visiting different offices. Large maps were presented today for "first viewing" and input for improvements was requested. There were no motions made.

**Accounting Policy/Procedures Review-** Commissioner Gohagan read a few pages from the Accounting Policies Manual and recommended revisions as necessary. There were no motions made.

**Adjourn:** With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Dougan made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day.
