

# COUNTY COMMISSION RECORD, CAMDEN COUNTY, MISSOURI

Tuesday 03/17/2026

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, First District Commissioner James Gohagan, and Second District Commissioner Steve Dougan.

## Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Dougan made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Dougan (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

## Prior Minutes

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes of March 10, 2026. Commissioner Dougan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Dougan (aye).

## New Business

**Marijuana Tax Revenue Payout**—Discussion whether the full amount of \$692k and some change or the current request of \$159,002.46 should be paid back to the Department of Revenue was had. Commissioner Dougan agreed with Auditor Jimmy Laughlin that the full amount should be paid back one time, so the issue was over and done with. Commissioner Skelton questioned why Camden County should pay that amount when there is no way of knowing whether DOR will ask for all of it back. Treasurer Kendra Hicks agreed with Commissioner Skelton as did Commissioner Gohagan. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to pay the Missouri Department of Revenue the requested amount of \$159,002.46. Commissioner Dougan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Dougan (aye).

**Release of Closed Session Minutes**— There were several sets of minutes presented for this agenda item that pertain to matters of the county that have sense been put to rest. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the releasing of old closed session minutes.





This concluded discussion of items on today's agenda. Commissioner Skelton opened the floor for public comment and/or other business. Camden County Prosecuting Attorney Richelle Grosvenor came forward.

### **Other Business**

Richelle Grosvenor first addressed the issue of the extensive backlog of cases she inherited when she won the election and took office in January of 2023. She stated she was told when she won the election it would take six years to get through this backlog. Their office has been working through the backlog for the past three years.

Another issue she described was the poor working relationship with the Camden County Sheriff Department staff member(s) and Camden County Prosecuting Attorney Office.

Her request to the Commission was for them to consider re-keying her office and the Sheriff Department's access to her office taken away or would like access to the information which shows who comes and goes from her office at any given time. An employee of the Sheriff's Department stated they do not have access to an audit trail which shows when key fobs/cards are used to open entryways. They stated when they need that information, they must contact the security company Elliott Data.

The Commissioners discussed with the Prosecuting Attorney ideas for resolving her access and safety concerns for her office/employees.

No motions were made.

Ordered that the Commission adjourn until further notice.
