New Business

Disbursement of Road Impact Fees to HSBSRD- It has been determined that no fees have been collected on Horseshoe Bend Special Road District roads, so funds will not be distributed to HSBSRD. There were no motions made. An amendment to Resolution 11-27-07-01 was made on April 10, 2025 which will allow Planning and Permitting to collect road impact fees on HSBSRD roads.

LOCLG Annual Membership Dues- Commissioner Skelton made a motion to table this discussion and vote until Thursday, April 24, 2025. Commissioner Dougan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Skelton (aye) and Commissioner Dougan (aye).

First Public Hearing for Reducing Speed Limit on County Roads: Thong Tree Road and Pershing Drive- This was the first of three hearings required by state statute.

Donna Sharp, full-time resident of Reflections Condominiums, was the only party present to speak on this matter. She submitted an email to all commissioners with her wishes for the commission to consider reducing the speed limit where Thong Tree Road and Pershing Drive split. There is a speed limit sign posted at 30 mph, but she has requested the limit be reduced to twenty-five. There were no motions made.
