The Camden County Commission met with First District Commissioner James Gohagan and Second District Commissioner Steve Dougan. Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton was absent.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Dougan made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Dougan (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Dougan made a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes of April 30, 2026. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Dougan (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

New Business

Bid opening- 260507 Tax Sale Publication—Two bids were received; one from The Reporter and one from Lake Sun. Commissioner Dougan made a motion to table this item until the next Commission meeting to give the Collector time to review the bids. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Dougan (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

2026 Agreement between Sheriff & Ozark Amphitheater for Security Service—There were no changes made between the 2025 and 2026 presented agreement. Commissioner Dougan made a motion to approve this agreement for deputy security services for the 2026 concert year at Ozark Amphitheater. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Dougan (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

The floor was opened for public comment. Sheriff Chris Edgar begins speaking to the commission regarding the human trafficking grant that was awarded to Camden County. Commissioner Skelton had asked the Sheriff previously about all the inventory that was purchased through grant funds; Sheriff Edgar didn't have knowledge of the whereabouts. Today, he presented information of the inventory purchased with the human trafficking grant funds and the location of the items. Sheriff Edgar iterated that he was not involved in deciding where the items went, which agencies were allowed to use the items, and all the grant direction was under the purview of Presiding Commissioner Skelton. Richelle Grosvenor spoke addressing two different groups in charge of human trafficking prevention—the civilian group and law enforcement task force.

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Dougan made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Dougan (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Session closed at 10:20 A.M.
