

COUNTY COMMISSION RECORD, CAMDEN COUNTY, MISSOURI

The Camden County Commission met with First District Commissioner James Gohagan and Second District Commissioner Steve Dougan. Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton was absent.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Dougan made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Dougan (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

The Commission did not vote on meeting minutes today.

Working Session

Sewer Board Term Replacement Appointment- Tiffany Blakely—Commissioner Dougan made a motion to appoint Tiffany Blakely to the Camden County Sewer Board to fulfill the remainder of Annette Richards' term. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Dougan (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Enterprise Fleet— Troy Douglas (Account Manager for the County) and Seth Linu (sp?) were present from Enterprise to discuss five vehicles in the Road and Bridge Department that are currently on lease and may possibly need replacing. Road and Bridge Employee Kendall Conklin inquired about possibly paying cash for a truck for his shed and not being on lease. Other items discussed include cash flow analysis, vehicle mileage, Sheriff Department vehicles, timeframe, and the overall partnership with Enterprise. No motions were made on this topic. Commissioner Dougan stated he would like more time to review and decide.

MEM- Workman's Comp. Discussion—Dale Muenks with Missouri Employers Mutual was present to conduct the county's annual review of accidents, deductible program, and safety grants. There were no motions made.

Other Issues/Communications/Updates—Stacey Robinett from the Prosecuting Attorney Office began addressing parking issues near CPS (probation office) and requested paint for parking lines. Some issues regarding the Sheriff Department were discussed, including the pump for the range bathroom and leaking windows at the Juvenile Justice Center. No motions were made.

Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Dougan (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Session closed at 11:28 A.M.
