Shall Macks Creek R-V School District of Camden County, Missouri, without an increase in the current debt service levy of the District, issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$1,500,000 for the purpose of improving, repairing and renovating the District's facilities, including (1) improving the kitchen, cafeteria, old gymnasium and weight room, (2) abating asbestos at various facilities and (3) to the extent funds are available, completing other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the District is estimated to remain unchanged from the current rate of \$0.4053 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

PROPOSITION #1
Shall the Gravois Fire Protection District, Morgan and Camden Counties, Missouri borrow money in the amount of eight million dollars for the purposes of decreasing response times to 911 emergency calls and carrying out its mission by acquiring, constructing, renovating, improving, furnishing and equipping fire stations, including a new fire station, and infrastructure in response to increased service demand; purchasing and equipping fire protection and firefighting apparatus, other vehicles, lifesaving medical equipment and auxiliary equipment; and refunding outstanding lease obligations and issue bonds for the repayment thereof?
The authorization of the bonds will authorize the levy and collection of an annual tax in addition to the other taxes provided for by law on all taxable tangible property in the District sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as they fall due and to retire the same within twenty years from the date thereof.
